
## THE STATE OF TEXAS

I, Trooper II Husain Roussel, being duly sworn do state upon my oath that I have good reason to believe and do believe and I charge that heretofore, and before the making and filing of this complaint that Cardenas, Fausto Deadly Conduct PC. on or about the 21 day of Jan., A.D. 20 10, 22.05 (b)(2)(F3) in the County of Travis and State of Texas, did then and there

On 01/21/2010 I was on duty in the south foyer of the Capitol. I heard what sounded like shots being fired on the south steps of the Capitol. When opened the south door and looked outside I did not notice anyone else except a white male subject that I later identified as Fausto Cardenas reloading a magazine. I approached Cardenas and asked him if he fired a gun. During the conversation with Cardenas I noticed that he had a pistol in his waistband. There were empty shell casing located in the area where Cardenas was confronted. It was determined that Cardenas knowingly discharged his weapon at the Capitol and was reckless as to whether or not the building was occupied.
